Payments cannot be processed by State facilities until the contract products have been delivered in satisfactory condition or services have been satisfactorily performed. Payment will be based on any invoice used in the supplier's normal course of business. However, such invoice must contain sufficient data including but not limited to contract number, description of product or service, quantity, unit and price per unit as well as federal identification number.

State facilities are required to forward properly completed vouchers to the Office of the State Comptroller for audit and payment. All facilities are urged to process every completed voucher expeditiously giving particular attention to those involving cash discounts for prompt payment.

If the contract terms indicate political subdivisions and others authorized by law are allowed to participate, those entities are required to make payments directly to the contractor. Prior to processing such payment, the contractor may be required to complete the ordering non-State agency's own voucher form.

PRICE:

GENERAL - Price is net, per quart, F.O.B. point of destination indicated in the “DELIVERY SCHEDULE” sheets. Price includes unloading by the contractor to the location and in the time frame stated in the “DELIVERY SCHEDULE”. Price shall also include milk coolers, dollies, etc., as may be required by the agencies.

MILK MARKETING ORDER - In the event of an increase or decrease in the class 1 (one) price including butterfat and skim milk prices, pursuant to the provisions of Article 21, as amended by Chapter 383 of the Laws of 1937, of the Agriculture and Markets Law, and/or Federal or State Milk Marketing Agreement or Order, the Office of General Services, Procurement Services Group, will authorize an adjustment of the prices paid for fluid milk products delivered under contract to facilities located in the milk marketing area.

Prices on fluid milk for facilities located in the Northeast Milk Marketing Area (NEMMA), are based on the class 1 (one) price announced by the Order’s Market Administrator for **July 2007** at Onondaga County (Syracuse, NY) and for facilities located in the Western New York Milk Marketing Area (WNYMMA), are based on the class 1 (one) price announced by the Order’s Market Administrator for **July 2007** at Monroe County (Rochester, NY). All milk products must conform with the definitions and standards of identity set forth in Part 17 of 1NYCRR.

In areas not subject to Federal or State Milk Marketing Orders, adjustments shall be computed on the same basis as those under the Northeast Milk Marketing Area.

CPI PRICE ADJUSTMENT - Pricing is firm through December 31, 2008. As of January 1, 2009 a price adjustment will be allowed based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for all Urban Consumers, Not Seasonally Adjusted, U.S. City Average, All Items (Series ID: CUUR0000SAO) as published by the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, Washington D. C. 20212. The index is available through the internet at the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) website at "www.bls.gov.com" If at any time, the above series ID is discontinued or not available, the State reserves the right to implement an applicable index.

Price adjustments using the CPI involve changing the base quart price for each type of fluid milk offered by the percent change in the level of the CPI between the reference period and a subsequent time period. The “reference” period shall be the month in which the bid opening was held and the subsequent time period shall be October. Every price adjustment shall be based on comparing the referenced period (July 2007) to the following subsequent CPI-U October figure. Each price adjustment shall be effective the following January.

Dairy Compact - In the event a dairy compact covering New York State becomes effective pursuant to State and/ or Federal law during the contract period and such compact's mandated price is higher than the price set for Class 1 (one) milk within the State pursuant to a State or Federal order, OGS will authorize price adjustments to reflect such compact pricing.

Deposit Charge for Milk Cases - The contractor shall assess a deposit charge as established by the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets for each milk case delivered to the using facility and which upon delivery remains at the premises of the facility. Ownership of each milk case properly identified with the name or other business identification of the person or company who is the owner remains with that owner notwithstanding the imposition of the deposit.

The deposit shall be held by the contractor so long as the milk case or its replacement remains on the facility premises and until such time as it is returned to the contractor in useful condition allowing for normal wear and use.

Milk Coolers/Dollies/Dispensers/Carts – For designated facilities, the contractor is required to provide milk coolers, dollies, dispensers or carts as indicated at no additional cost.

No additional charge for this equipment will be allowed. The dollies, dispensers or carts are to be provided, installed, maintained and replaced (if necessary) by the contractor at the contractor's expense. On conclusion of the contract, the equipment remains the property of the contractor and is to be removed at contractor's expense.

Additional Sites/Additional Products – State agencies and political subdivisions may participate in contracts resulting from this bid opening even though they may not appear on the "DELIVERY SCHEDULE" sheets. Those State agencies and political subdivisions who wish to participate in these contracts after the award has been issued may do so with the concurrence of a contractor closely located to them and with the approval of the OGS Procurement Services Group. The contractor must be willing to extend the same pricing, terms and conditions and be agreeable to their delivery requirements. If the augmentation of an additional site to an Item results in a substantive change of a particular milk product's volume from the original bid quantity, the State reserves the right to negotiate a lower per quart base price for that milk product for every delivery location within the Item (region).

If the specific type of milk and/or the specific type of packaging/size is not listed, and there is a need by a contract participant, the State reserves the right to add the needed product/size. Pricing in such an event is to be commensurate with other product of a similar type/size.

Unworkable Price Structure - Should the price structure utilized by the parties become unworkable, detrimental or injurious to the State and/or Contractor or result in prices which are not truly reflective of current market conditions, and the price is deemed unreasonable or excessive by the Commissioner and no adjustment in price is mutually agreeable, the Commissioner reserves the sole right upon 10 days written notice mailed to the contractor to terminate any contract resulting from this bid opening. If the contractor is unable or unwilling to meet contractual requirements in whole or in part based on an unworkable price structure, it shall immediately notify the State of that fact in order that the State may take appropriate action. Such notification shall be in writing and shall be directed to the Office of General Services, Procurement Services Group. Such notification shall not relieve the contractor of its responsibilities under the contract.

The State reserves the right to implement changes in price based on unforeseen factors such as dramatic changes in availability, delivery, costs, etc., for product, supplies, etc., that substantively affect the contractor's business processes or that may impact contract pricing. Such changes may be based on information from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, industry data, or other sources.

## PRICE: (Cont'd)

Lower Pricing - The State reserves the right to negotiate lower pricing, or to advertise for bids, whichever is in the State's best interest as determined by the Commissioner, in the event of a significant decrease in market price of any product listed. In addition, if the contractor's normal pricing to the public or to the trade in general is less than the net/contract pricing with the application of a contract discount, etc., then the normal pricing to the public or to the trade in general shall also be granted to contract participants.

## DELIVERY:

General - Deliveries are to be made strictly in accordance with orders, on the day and date and within the time frame specified, in clean properly sealed containers and at a maximum temperature of 45° Fahrenheit on delivery.

Restricted Delivery - Price includes "restricted" delivery. Delivery to some facilities, particularly Correctional Facilities, have delivery "restricted" --- delivery must be made during certain hours, and must be made only on weekdays (Monday through Friday) except/excluding State holidays. Price shall also include contacting the agency prior to making delivery. Deliveries are to be made in crates which are acceptable to the facility - wire mesh crates may not be acceptable. [See also "PACKAGING – CONTAINERS FOR CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES"]

Delivery Schedule – The separate "DELIVERY SCHEDULE" for Award 20800 which provides expanded information on locations, required delivery days and times, special equipment, etc. (See also "ADDITIONAL SITES" of "PRICE" clause.)

Discrepancy on Purchase Order - Delivery shall be made in accordance with instructions on Purchase Order from each agency. If there is a discrepancy between the purchase order and what is listed on the contract, it is the contractor's obligation to seek clarification from the ordering agency and, if applicable, from the Office of General Services, Procurement Services Group.

## CONTRACT PERIOD AND RENEWALS:

It is the intention of the State to enter into a contract for the term as stated herein.

If mutually agreed between the Procurement Services Group and the contractor, the contract may be renewed under the same terms and conditions for additional period(s) not to exceed a total contract term of five (5) years.

## SHORT TERM EXTENSION:

In the event the replacement contract has not been issued, any contract let and awarded hereunder by the State, may be extended unilaterally by the State for an additional period of up to one month upon notice to the contractor with the same terms and conditions as the original contract including, but not limited to, quantities (prorated for such one month extension), prices, and delivery requirements. With the concurrence of the contractor, the extension may be for a period of up to three months in lieu of one month. However, this extension terminates should the replacement contract be issued in the interim.

## CANCELLATION FOR CONVENIENCE

The State of New York retains the right to cancel this contract, in whole or in part without reason provided that the Contractor is given at least sixty (60) days notice of its intent to cancel. This provision should not be understood as waiving the State's right to terminate the contract for cause or stop work immediately for unsatisfactory work, but is supplementary to that provision. Any such cancellation shall have no effect on existing Agency agreements, which are subject to the same 60 day discretionary cancellation or cancellation for cause by the respective user Agencies.

**RESERVATION:**

The State reserves the right to negotiate lower pricing, or to advertise for bids, any unanticipated excessive purchase. An "unanticipated excessive purchase" is defined as an unexpected order for a contract product(s) totaling more than \$50,000.00.

**SOURCE OF SUPPLY:**

All milk products shall be from producers whose farms are subject to the supervision of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets or other duly authorized agencies if producers are located outside New York State.

**PERMIT AND LICENSE:**

All milk must be from sources approved by the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets and the contractor must hold a regular permit from the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets. Contractor must also hold a milk dealer's license as required by the Department of Agriculture and Markets.

Required licenses and health permits shall be effective at all times during the period of the contract. Cancellation or revocation of license for non-compliance with any order of the Commissioner of Agriculture and Markets shall automatically cancel the contract.

**INSPECTION:**

An agency, any of its officers, or any properly authorized representative of the State shall have the right to inspect the premises, facilities and methods on or by which such milk is produced, and may make, or cause to be made, standard tests of any milk delivered for the purpose of determining whether the contract is being properly performed.

**INFERIOR DELIVERIES:**

Inferior deliveries will be rejected, except where milk has been used prior to receipt of laboratory reports from the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets on official samples showing deficiency in quality. Such milk will be paid for as follows:

**MILK -** For each one-tenth of one percent of butterfat content found less than the minimum established requirements there shall be deducted one cent per quart.

If two or more samples taken from deliveries of milk are found to contain bacteria in excess of the standards specified, the contract shall be canceled. The undelivered quantities may be purchased in the open market and any difference in cost shall be charged to the contractor.

All deliveries must be made strictly in accordance with instructions appearing on the purchase order. Failure to deliver as specified will result in rejection upon arrival. Immediate replacement may be made from the open market at the contractor's expense.

**EMERGENCY PURCHASING:**

In the event that a disaster emergency is declared by Executive Order under Section 28 of Article 2-B of the Executive Law, or that the Commissioner determines pursuant to his/her authority under Section 163(10)(b) of the State Finance Law that an emergency exists requiring the prompt and immediate delivery of products or services, the Commissioner reserves the right to obtain such products or services from any source, including but not limited to this contract, as the Commissioner in his/her sole discretion determines will meet the needs of such emergency. Contractor shall not be entitled to any claim or lost profits for products or services procured from other sources pursuant to this paragraph.

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**DIESEL EMISSION REDUCTION ACT OF 2006 (NEW REQUIREMENT OF LAW):**

On February 12, 2007 the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act took effect as law (the "Law"). Pursuant to new §19-0323 of the N.Y. Environmental Conservation Law ("NYECL") it is now a requirement that heavy duty diesel vehicles in excess of 8,500 pounds use the best available retrofit technology ("BART") and ultra low sulfur diesel fuel ("ULSD"). The requirement of the Law applies to all vehicles owned, operated by or on behalf of, or leased by State agencies and State or regional public authorities. They need to be operated exclusively on ULSD by February 12, 2007. It also requires that such vehicles owned, operated by or on behalf of, or leased by State agencies and State or regional public authorities with more than half of its governing body appointed by the Governor utilize BART.

As a contract vendor the Law may be applicable to vehicles used by contract vendors "on behalf of" State agencies and public authorities. Thirty-three percent (33%) of affected vehicles must have BART by December 31, 2008, sixty-six percent (66%) by December 31, 2009 and one-hundred percent (100%) by December 31, 2010. The Law provides a list of exempted vehicles. Regulations currently being drafted will provide further guidance as to the effects of the Law on contract vendors using heavy duty diesel vehicles on behalf of the State. The Law also permits waivers of ULSD and BART under limited circumstances at the discretion of the Commissioner of Environmental Conservation. The Law will also require reporting from State agencies and from contract vendors in affected contracts.

Therefore, the contractor hereby certifies and warrants that all heavy duty vehicles, as defined in NYECL §19-0323, to be used under this contract, will comply with the specifications and provisions of NYECL §19-0323, and any regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, which requires the use of BART and ULSD, unless specifically waived by NYSDEC. Qualification and application for a waiver under this Law will be the responsibility of the contractor.

**COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL FOOD, DRUG AND COSMETIC ACT, AS WELL AS OTHER REGULATIONS:**

The contractor, processor, and/or the manufacturer guarantees any product delivered complies in all respects with, and is not adulterated or misbranded within the meaning of standards and regulations established by Federal or New York State laws - - - this includes the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, decisions of the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and decisions of the U.S. Department of Commerce.

The vendor may be required to submit letter of guarantee from manufacturer stating their compliance with Federal and/or New York State laws and regulations.

**E. COLI:**

No Escherichia coli 0157:H7, or any other pathogens, are permitted in any product.

**PACKAGING - APPROVALS:**

All required approvals or acceptances must be obtained prior to the start of the contract. It is the responsibility of the contractor to make sure that equipment and containers offered have received the current approval of the Office of General Services, Procurement Services Group.

**PACKAGING - BULK MILK:**

Where specified, bulk milk is to be supplied in double polyethylene bag in box, 10 qt. rigid blow molded polyethylene one piece single service containers, or 12 qt. #300 plastic GeF containers. The box shall be a single wall, plastic coated corrugated container which shall fit the serving equipment to be furnished by the contractor. All containers must have the acceptance of the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets. The filling machine must also have such acceptance.

Auto taps are required for all types of containers and sufficient caps shall be furnished to allow one for each tilt rack space. Necessary replacements, in order to maintain constant service, are to be furnished by the contractor without charge.

**PACKAGING - CONTAINERS FOR CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES:**

Correctional Facilities, and some other institutions or facilities, require packaging and containers which do not present security problems (i.e., wire, metal, sharp edges, etc., which may be easily removed and fashioned into a weapon).
