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FROZEN YOGURT, FURNITURE POP-UP COMING TO THE CONCOURSE

Office of General Services (OGS) Commissioner RoAnn Destito today announced that later this month state workers and visitors to the Empire State Plaza will have new options for indulging their sweet tooth and decorating their homes: *á la Mode* – Frozen Yogurt and Waffles, and a new Pop-Up at the Plaza store will feature hand-crafted furniture sold by Narmouné.

The new ***á la Mode*** is scheduled to open in mid-June and will feature eight different flavors of self-service frozen yogurt and sorbet with an assortment of toppings. *Á la Mode* will also feature made-to-order Liege waffles, which have a texture similar to a doughnut.

The store, operated by Mazzone Hospitality, will be using products from Dannon, which has its headquarters in New York State. *Á la Mode* will be located by the Red Cross donation center, just down the Concourse from the new Egg box office, and will be open from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. on weekdays.

Following the Valentine's and Spring Restoration Pop-Up At The Plaza Events, the next OGS pop-up will be the **Narmouné** furniture showroom and sales floor in the former Hallmark space. It will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. from June 12 to June 23.

Narmouné describes its furniture as functional art that is created by skilled craftsmen who want their work to be both practically useful and continually admired. Designs by Narmouné are meant to provide individuality and worldliness to the modern home.
