FOUR COMPANIES RECEIVE NEW YORK STATE SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION

The Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following four businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

- Castlebar Corporation is a global sourcing, manufacturer, and supply chain management solutions provider.
- Alta Vista Solutions specializes in civil engineering.
- Kilda Group, LLC provides program management, consulting, and other services.
- Genoya, LLC is an information technology service provider.

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of June 9, 2017, a total of 337 businesses have been certified. The Act promotes and encourages participation of SDVOBs in NYS public procurements of public works, commodities, services and technology to foster and advance economic development in the State.
