**THIRTEEN COMPANIES RECEIVE NEW YORK STATE
SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION**

The Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following thirteen businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

- 3D Industrial Sales and Service Inc., located in Westbury, NY, Distributes HVAC equipment.

- Bristol Enterprises Inc., located in Buffalo, NY, is a framing contractor and locksmith.
- Trinity Rock Construction, located in Chestertown, NY, specializes in dump trucking, excavation, cabin construction, and storm drain systems.
- Anchor Freight Inc., located in Pine Bush, NY, provides general construction, paving, roofing, framing, and masonry.
- DV Enterprises of WNY LLC, located in East Aurora, NY, is a general construction contractor specializing in concrete flatwork, and excavation.
- Renua Energy Inc., located in Red Hook, NY, practice construction engineering and energy consultant services.
- Watson Engineering, P.C., located in Owego, NY, works in mechanical, electrical, and plumbing engineering.

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of July 6, 2017, a total of 354 businesses have been certified.
