FOUR COMPANIES RECEIVE NEW YORK STATE SERVICE-DISABLED VETERAN-OWNED BUSINESS CERTIFICATION

The Office of General Services Commissioner today announced that the following four businesses have recently been certified by the Office of General Services' (OGS) Division of Service-Disabled Veterans' Business Development (DSDVBD):

- Anadine Design & Development Corp., located in Buffalo, NY, provides construction management services in all trades.
- TruWeather Solutions LLC, located in Albany, NY, specializes in weather forecasting.
- Bethlehem Land Surveying PLLC, located in Delmar, NY, provides land surveying services.
- Walker PMC LLC, located in Black River, NY, is a construction and project management contractor.

The Division was created by Governor Andrew Cuomo in May, 2014 with enactment of the Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act. As of November 7, 2017, a total of 394 businesses have been certified.

The Act promotes and encourages participation of SDVOBs in NYS public procurements of public works, commodities, services and technology to foster and advance economic development in the State. More information on the program and the certification process can be found here
